Lisa's Kidding Supply List:

- Iodine 7%** - Use for dipping navels and wound treatment
- Tetanus Antitoxin**- 1500 unit bottle-Fast acting/short term tetanus for castrating & disbudding
- Bose-** (Get from Vet)- 1/4cc per new born to prevent white muscle disease
- C&D/T vaccine**- For overeating disease with tetanus toxoid (long acting)
- Lamb nipples**- Pritchard teat (screw on) or Miller (slip on)
- Frozen colostrum**- for weak Kids
- Milk replacer**- For unexpected bummer Kids
- Pop bottles**- For feeding milk replacer
- Measuring cup**- To measure milk replacer
- Thermometer**- To check for chilled/feverished kid or feverish Doe
- Elastrator Tool**- For applying elastrator rings-castrating
- Elastrator Rings**- Small green rubber rings
- Alcohol 70%**- To store unused elastrator rings and to keep clean
- Heat lamp**- For cold nights
- Lamb puller**-To pull large Kids at birthing time
- O.B. gloves**- For pulling Kids-Wrist and Shoulder length
- Lubricant**- for O.B. gloves
- Betadine**-Cleanser
- Syringes**- 3cc and 6cc-most common for vaccinating
- Needles**-22 gauge x 3/4" for Kids / 20 gauge x 1" for Does
- Towels**- Old bath towels for drying off Kids
- Paper Towels**-Handy for cleaning up
- Sissors**- For removal of fiber so Kids can find teats
- Tattooer and Digits**- Tattooing required to register Pygora's.
- ID tags**- to identify Kids for own record keeping (optional-handy for large herds)
- ID tagger**- For applying ID tags (Optional)
- Propylene Glycol**- Quick energy source for ketosis
- Molasses**- Free choice to Does before kidding to guard against ketosis
- Collar and leash**- To hold Doe if assistance is needed
- Flashlight**
- Weigh scale**- to weigh Kids to make sure they are gaining weight
- Uterine Boluses**- Uterine antibiotic if you assisted delivery
- Sheep Vitamin & Mineral Drench**- for unthrifty newborns & kids
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
